**The Communion**

*All baptized Christians are welcome to receive Communion. If you wish to receive a blessing only, please come forward and indicate to the priest by crossing your arms over your chest.*

*Intinction (dipping the bread in the wine) is no longer practised here for health reasons. If you do not wish to receive the common cup, you may place both hands on the chalice as a gesture of acceptance or simply cross your arms over your chest. The Church's stance is that in taking only the bread, you are receiving the full blessing of the Body and Blood of Christ.*
